

# Common Ground Adelaide Ltd



Common Ground Adelaide Ltd was established in December 2006. Prominent business leaders came together with state government to launch Common Ground as a new financial and service model to assist homeless and other low income South Australians into affordable and stable housing.



Common Ground is a new form of affordable housing supply and an operational service model, which provides socially inclusive rental housing for a tenant mix, comprising of people with a history of homelessness and other low income groups seeking affordable housing. This model was successfully pioneered by Rosanne Haggerty in New York in 1990.

To date, Common Ground Adelaide has acquired and operated, for two years, 37 apartments in their Franklin Street property and commenced work to complete the new Light Square project. This new building project will feature 52 self-contained apartments, including 16 one bedroom apartments and 36 studio apartments. Light Square will also be the head office and service centre for Common Ground's operations in the city.

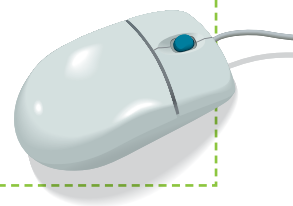
